The effect on self-esteem and motivation of reading one's first book in the foreign language is undeniable. The activities can also help students improve their writing or speaking ability. Another activity teachers can become involved in is individual counseling- this gives the teacher an opportunity to ask students about their reading experiences and can be done by the teacher while the rest of the classes are silent reading.
